# EDGES Research Grant Funding Available Deadline: July 1, 2023, 5:00 PM ET

The Foundation is accepting applications for the **Early-Career Development Grant for Echo Scientists (EDGES)**. This program will award **three grants worth up to \$25,000 USD** to fund projects that address a clinical gap in cardiovascular ultrasound imaging through research led by an early career scientist. There are no specific research themes that will be prioritized, and clinical gaps may include, but are not limited to: new imaging technologies, novel approaches or populations for diagnostic imaging, ultrasound therapy,



workflow automation, or patient/practitioner safety. Physicians, PhDs, veterinarians, sonographers, and other healthcare professionals who are within seven years from having completed training are eligible to apply. Full application details available online <a href="here">here</a>.
