Impact of Echo Report Recommendations for Severe Valvular Heart Disease Research Grant

Applications Due: August 31, 2022

Multi-year funding (up to two years) valued at up to \$1.1M USD is available for a project that aims to examine the impact of embedded echocardiography report interventions on referral patterns and outcomes in patients newly diagnosed by echocardiography with severe aortic stenosis (AS). This study in particular will examine the role of a primary care provider and referral patterns to a cardiac specialist for patients presenting with severe AS, though the study may be expanded to include other forms of severe valve disease. One grant will be awarded by ASE through the Foundation, with the support of funding from Edwards Lifesciences. More information available here.
