Early-Career Development Grants Available for Echo Scientists - Apply Today!

The application to the 2024 <u>Early-Career Development</u> <u>Grant for Echo Scientists (EDGES)</u> is open. The program awards three grants worth up to \$25,000 USD to fund projects that address a clinical gap in cardiovascular ultrasound imaging through research led by an early-career scientist. There are no specific research themes that will be prioritized, and clinical gaps may include, but are not limited to: new imaging technologies, novel approaches or populations for diagnostic imaging, ultrasound therapy,



workflow automation, or patient/practitioner safety. Physicians, PhDs, veterinarians, sonographers, and other healthcare professionals who are within seven years from having completed training are eligible to **apply now through July 1, 2024, 5:00 PM ET**. The principal investigator must be an active ASE member.
